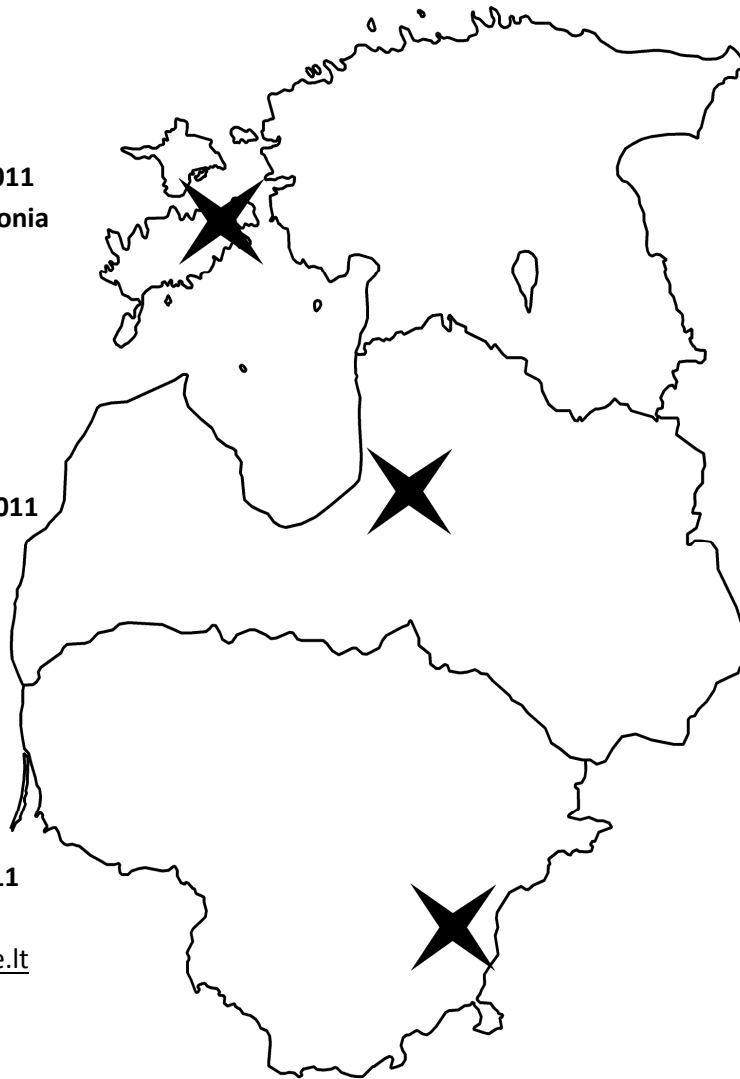


Baltic Adventure Racing Championships

RACES

Baltic Adventure Racing Championships consists of three races:

June 4	Vilnius Challenge	Vilnius, Lithuania	urban adventure race
July 30	Ace Xdream	Saaremaa, Estonia	night race
September 17	xRace	Sigulda, Latvia	race + award ceremony

SCORING

- Baltic Adventure Racing Championships points are given to all finished and ranked teams in all three races.
- Scores in each race are calculated both for the long course and the short course. Points are distributed according to the following logic: 1st place - 400pt, 2nd - 380, 3rd - 370, 4 - 360, 5 - 355, 6 - 350, 7 - 347, 8 - 344, 9 - 342, 10 - 340, 11 - 339, ... , 349 - 1, 350 - 0.
- Baltic Adventure Racing Championships total score is the sum of all races.
- In case two or more teams have equal points, higher places at later races have more weight. In other words, the importance of races is Sigulda, Saaremaa and Vilnius.
- Based on scores, teams are ranked in three classes: **men, women and mix**.

PRIZES

For the first year, the race is about glory. Each member of the best team in each class of the long course is awarded with the title **the Baltic Champion of Adventure Racing**.

Three best teams in each class of the long course are awarded with Baltic Championships medals. Short course teams will be ranked and three best teams in each class are awarded with diplomas.

RULES

- Each race is organised according to its own rules.
- Forecasted winning time of the long course is 6-9 hours in all races.
- The team name and class must be exactly the same in all three races.
- Team members can change from race to race without restrictions. Team size: Vilnius Challenge 2 members; Ace Xdream and xRace 3 members.
